She began her career at a technical college where she earned a degree in television production. During her studies in college, she gained enough hands-on, practical knowledge to work as a production assistant at a television station. Jackie spent several years in both news and production, she instantly knew she'd found her calling. She then moved to Atlanta to help launch a young upstart company Crawford Communications, a premiere post-production facility specializing in broadcast television, satellite, Internet, post and audio. Her recent credits include providing post-production services for PSAV who specializes in planning, producing and executing complex presentations and business theater events. Through her work for PSAV she has had the opportunity to post show content for companies such as Hilton Hotels, Omni Hotels and APICS the association for operations management.

Gammie along with producer John San Miguel won the national AIME, Telly and Aegis awards for a parent teen educational project they collaborated on for Marietta City Schools. This past year she provided post production services for Above & Beyond - a DVD release of the Washington DC memorial ceremony celebrating the 60th Anniversary of the Japanese surrender and the end of WW II including a series of virtual conversations between service men & women of today's military & WW II Vets about honor, sacrifice & gratitude, as well as Managing Pressures Before Marriage and Media Madness - two nationally distributed abstinence and media literacy courses for young teens.
